CHOCOLATE CUPCAKES

This recipe makes one dozen (12) cupcakes.

Change this recipe to make 4 dozen cupcakes for a birthday party.

Chocolate cake mixture

100g butter
 $\frac{2}{3}$ cup caster sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla essence
2 eggs
1 cup self-raising flour
 $\frac{1}{3}$ cup cocoa
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon bicarbonate soda
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup milk

Chocolate frosting

60g unsalted butter
 $1\frac{1}{4}$ cups icing sugar
1 tablespoon cocoa
1 tablespoon milk



GINGERBREAD

This recipe makes enough for 6 people.

Change it so there is enough for 3 people for an after-school treat.

Gingerbread mixture

360 g unsalted butter
420 g caster sugar
600 g Golden syrup
2 teaspoons cinnamon
 $2\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons ground ginger
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons ground nutmeg
1 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons bicarbonate soda
1240g plain flour

Royal frosting

2 egg whites
400g icing sugar

ANSWERS

CHOCOLATE CUPCAKES

400g butter
2 $\frac{2}{3}$ cup caster sugar
4 teaspoon vanilla essence
8 eggs
4 cup self-raising flour
1 $\frac{1}{3}$ cup cocoa
2 teaspoons bicarbonate soda
2 cups milk
240g unsalted butter
5 cups icing sugar
4 tablespoons cocoa
4 tablespoons milk

GINGERBREAD

180 g unsalted butter
210 g caster sugar
300 g Golden syrup
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon ground ginger
 $\frac{3}{4}$ teaspoon ground nutmeg
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon bicarbonate soda
620g plain flour
1 egg white
200g icing sugar
