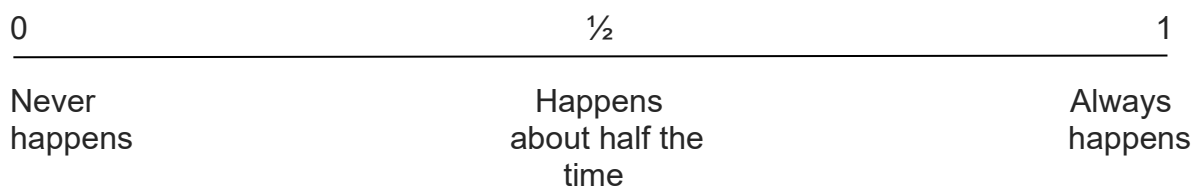

PROBABILITY PREDICTION

The prediction number line below (from zero to one) can be used to assign numbers to the likelihood of particular events occurring.

Zero indicates that something will never happen.

One indicates that the event is certain to occur.



Write a good prediction number for each listed event using the number line to help.

Q1. You drop a stone and it falls

Q2. A circle has four sides

Q3. It will rain tomorrow

Q4. You will live to be 200 years old

Q5. You toss a coin and it turns up heads

Q6. Rectangles have four vertices

Q7. A boy is younger than his father

Q8. A die is rolled and an even number occurs

Q9. A triangle has four sides

Q10. A double occurs when two dice are tossed.
